Department of Neonatology conducted a CME - Genomic Medicine – A Primer” on 7th March 2024

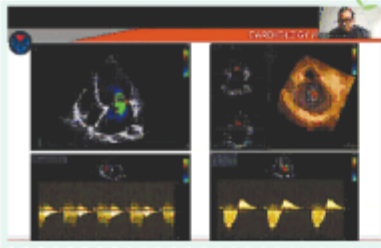

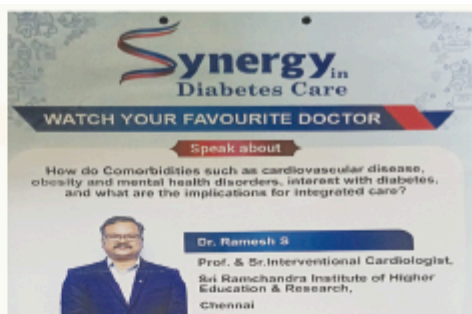
The Department of Psychiatry organized National Anti – Drug Addiction Day on 2nd October 2024.

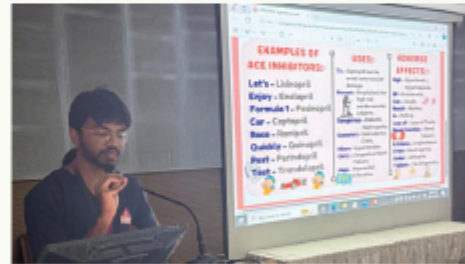
The Department of Critical Care Medicine organized the 18th Annual Workshop on Principles & Practice of Mechanical Ventilation on 5th & 6th October 2024.

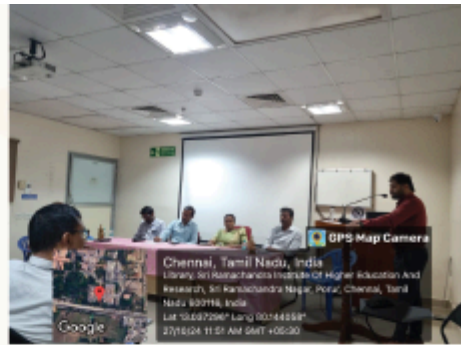

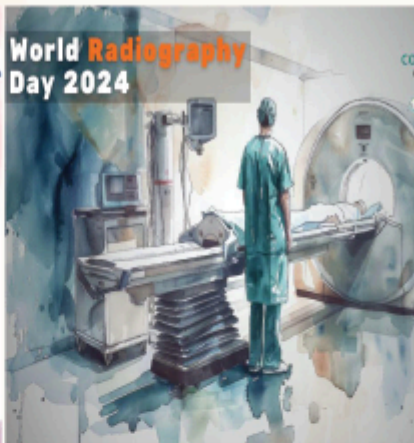

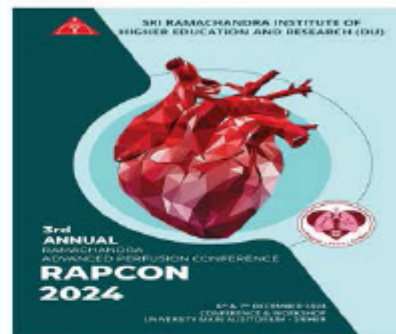
